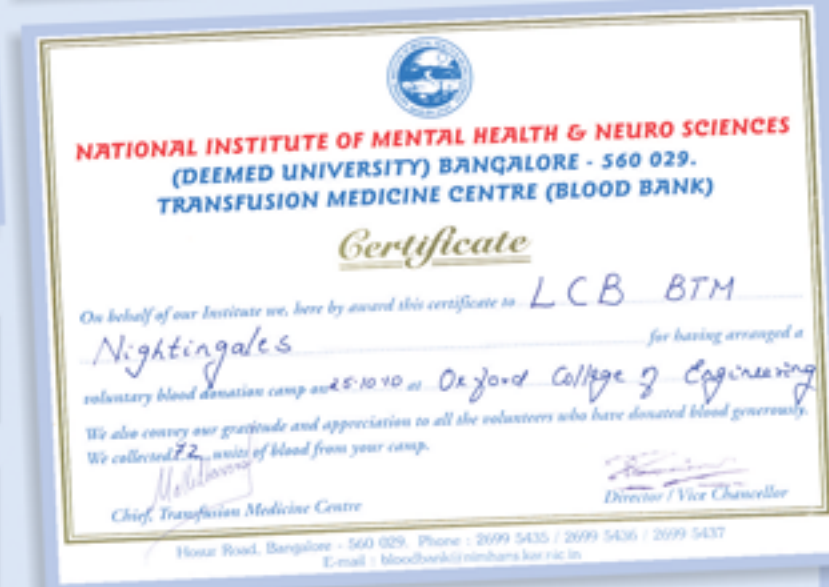
The unselfish effort to bring cheer to others will be the beginning of a happier life for ourselves.

Secretary report for the second quarter

At the outset I am proud to tell you all that our club was presented the KNIGHT OF THE BLIND award by the International president Ln. Sid.L Scruggs for our efforts in eye screening program. Our club totally screened 35000 school children for sight problems.

Women empowerment

- (i) On 12th September, the day on which our club sponsored the new club, LCB Kudlu 4 sewing machines were given to women below poverty line as a part of our service.
- (ii) Our club started free tailoring and embroidery classes to BPL women at Eijjipura. Machines were donated for the programme.
- (iii) On 20.1.11 our club started bakery training classes in coordination with JSS at government school Kormangala.

Service to the physically challenged

- 1. On the occasion of our international president Lnsid L. Scruggs visit to our district 324d6 mega service activity was conducted in which our Club donated 6 wheel chairs to the needy.
- 2. Our club gave Rs 3000 as scholarship to Kum. Megha a 10th std student for her 2nd term fees.

Permanent projects

- (i) Our first permanent project-Maternity camp on every first Monday of the month is going on successfully with more patients getting benefitted. We thank the donors for their generous help.
- (ii) We started our second permanent project-adopting a government school. We have started computers classes and set up a good library. I thank our members for putting a lot of effort to make it a Model school.
- (iii) The third permanent project was started in Kormangala. Free Diabetic and cardio check up camp which will be conducted on every third Saturday of the month. 250 patients were benefitted in the first month.

Health camps

- (i) Our club had a twinning programme with rural Club of Bangarpet on 10th October to conduct an eye camp. 250 patients were screened and 25 were identified for cataract operation
- (ii) On the same day we had one more eye camp at Kysambali near K.G.F. which was jointly organised by Vemana charitable trust. 450 patients were screened and 34 were identified for cataract operation.
- (iii) We started our DG 1-1 million eye screening programme on 28th October. By 15th November

we screened 35684 children and 3300 were found to have vision problems.

In collaboration with Dr. Agarwal eye Hospital the final screening of this 3300 children will be done and free spectacles will be given to the poor children.

- (iv) On 21st January we had speech and hearing screening by Dr. Chandrashekar for the children of government school at CRPF Quarters. 200 children were screened and 30 were sent for further investigation.
- (v) On 27th November we had a general health check up camp at Chikeka Tirupathi with the coordination of Honey well software logistic. 475 patients were treated and free medicines were given.

Blood donation

On 25th October we organised a blood donation camp at Oxford engineering college Bomanahalli. 274 units of blood was collected by KIDWAI, Lions Blood Bank, Lady Bowring and Curzon Hospital.

Environment

- (i) On 11/12/10 we planted 30 neem saplings at Harlur village.
- (ii) On the occasion of our VDGI In Ramachandran's birthday we had a twinning service activity with lions club of Doddabalapur and lioness club of Doddabalapur. 50 saplings were planted at the Government college. 5000 saplings will be planted by our club in a phased manner.

Other activities

- (i) Children's day was celebrated along with lions clubs of our district at Palace grounds. 25 children sponsored by our club participated in the painting completion organised that day.
- (ii) Celebrated Kannada rajyotsava with lions club of Peenya and 27 other clubs at Vijayanagar club.
- (iii) I am happy to say that 11 new members were inducted into our club with a growth of 32%.
- (iv) On October 2nd on the occasion of Gandhi jayanthi we honoured Professor Ramaswamy a gandhain and a man behind cartman and an animal rights activist.
